SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE: Returning members wishing to receive an enrollment scholarhsip must fill out and return the enrollment and scholarship form BEFORE January 31, 2024. Scholarship amounts will be determined on a case by case basis. Members will be expected to pay a portion of the enrollment fee.


Enrollment Fees for 2023-24 Year

- If enrolled by Wed, Jan 31, 2024; the first two family members will be \$70 each and additional family members will be \$40.00
- If enrolled: Thur, Feb 1 May 1, 2024; each member will be \$90; no family discount will be offered
- If enrolled on or After Thur May 2; Member will NOT be eligible to compete as a 4-Her at County or State Fair.
- CLOVERBUD ENROLLMENT: \$40 each regardless of date

### YOUTH ARE NOT ENROLLED UNTIL PAYMENT IS MADE

4-H Levels for this year are calculated as of September 1, 2023
5-8 years = Cloverbud
9-11 years = Junior
12 -14 years = Intermediate
15 -19 years = Senior







# Merv & Sally Fleming College/Trade/Technical School Scholarships

For current year graduating seniors that are Horse or Non-market 4-H members.

Deadline: March 1<sup>st</sup>, Amount: \$2500

### **Requirements:**

- Must be currently enrolled in Deschutes county Horse 4-H and/or a Non-market Animal 4-H project and be a current year high school graduate. Members participating in the livestock auction are not eligible.
- Can win Scholarship only once.
- Transcripts are requested, but only average grades are required. Grade points are not considered a priority for this scholarship.
- Scholarship can be used at any college (community college, trade school, vocational school, 4-year college etc.)
- Scholarship will be given for the <u>second</u> term in college/trade school.
- Scholarship winners are expected to participate in the current year county fair to complete eligibility.
- Finalists will be interviewed. Interviews will be scheduled during the month of March. If you are to be interviewed, we'll make an appointment.
- Two or three alternates will be chosen as there is always a chance that plans will change regarding fair or college.
- All committee decisions are final.
