 - 2. Describe your most challenging leadership experience (either in or out of 4-H) and how your 4-H experience helped you in the situation.
 - 3. Describe the role community service and citizenship activities have played in your life both in and out of 4-H.
- Write an essay answering the following (also listed on page 2):
 How has 4-H impacted your life? How does continuing education help further your life goals?

Selection Process

The 4-H Extension Agent will arrange for a Scholarship Selection Committee with interviews and selection to take place shortly after the application deadline. The application materials are available online to download or can be mailed to individual candidates as needed. The Selection Committee will evaluate all candidates according to the selection criteria as follows:
