

# Crook County 4-H/FFA Market Animal Health Certification

We, the undersigned, certify that the market animal being shown and sold by \_\_\_\_\_ (*print exhibitors full name*) at the Crook County Fair has not received antibiotics or other drugs 30 days prior to Crook County Fair, or if the animal has received approved antibiotics or drugs in the past 30 days, the animal has met labeled withdrawal periods for slaughter. If for any reason this animal is found not to be in compliance with USDA or PSIS regulations concerning residue levels, we understand that we will incur any monetary penalty and the Crook County Fair or the Crook County 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale Association, Inc. will not be held financially liable. We also understand that animals to be shown and sold at the Crook County Fair may be subject to random or spot urinalysis testing and that any animal not found to be in compliance will be sent home immediately.

We attest that to the best of our knowledge, the **BEEF /SHEEP /SWINE /GOAT /RABBITS /POULTRY** (*circle one*) under our authority, direction, or ownership and which are supplied to the chosen processing plant for slaughter have not been fed "prohibited" mammalian protein (i.e. ruminant meat, bone meal &/or dog food) as defined by FDA Directive 589.2000. FDA Directive 589.2000 requires ruminant feeders to keep records for all feed they receive that contains animal protein products, whether or not the animal protein is prohibited material. Such records would include purchase invoices and labeling for all feeds containing animal protein products received. Copies of these records are to be made available to FDA upon request
