## **Facts**

≫	Gestation Period	-145 to 155 days
>	Estrus Period	-2 to 3 Days
>	Breeding Season	-August to Mid-March
>	Number of Offspring	-Average of 2 per kidding
≫	Number of Front Teeth	8
>	Average weight of an adult goat	40-70 pounds
≫	Average weight of a kid	2-4 pounds

## **Information**

- > Milking does need twice as much feed as pregnant does
- > Goats can be weaned at about 10 weeks of age
- > Plants that are poisonous to goats:
  - x Azalea
  - x Rhododendron
  - x Laurel
  - x Tansy Ragwort
- > Does are usually bred at 7 to 10 months of age.
- > Castrate male kids as soon as the testicles descend into the scrotum (7 days to 3 weeks).
- > Trim hooves about 4 times a year.
- > Prevention is the single most important issue in regarding pygmy goat health care.
- > Goat Colors:
  - ✓ Agouti- Dark goats ranging from silver-gray to black with solid stockings that are darker than the main body color.
  - ✓ Caramel- Light colored goats ranging from white to light brown. Caramels have vertical stripes on front of dark stockings.
  - ✓ Solid Black- No stockings or white anywhere.
  - ✓ Black- No Stockings with solid black, except around eyes, nose, and ears.
