Instructions and More Information

For members to earn points at horse sponsored event (or any event where there was a 4-H sign-in sheet):

- 1) Notification must go out to all members prior to event from the 4-H Horse Advisory or OSU Extension Office.
- 2) Members must attend a minimum of two (2) hours or the duration of the event.
- 3) Members must sign-in/out, and the sign-in list should be given to the Points keeper by the Leader/Organizer of the event within 30 days of event conclusion.
- 4) Clinics must include a lecture and/or instruction.

Procedure for turning in proof of non-horse 4-H event, horse volunteering, and other volunteering (without compensation):

Turn in a volunteer hour reporting sheet to the points keeper no later than 30 days after the event. (This can be taken to a 4-H Horse Advisory meeting or scanned and emailed directly to the points keeper – Sally Gregory at dwrayg@yahoo.com).

A record of point status for each 4-H Horse member will be maintained by the points keeper. Points will be updated monthly and will be distributed at the monthly 4-H Horse Advisory Meetings. All points must be earned and reported to the points keeper prior to submitting an entry form for 4-H County Horse Fair. See 4-H Calendar for 4-H Fair entry deadline.

The Senior, Intermediate, and Junior members earning the most points during the 4-H year will receive a special recognition award during 4-H County Horse Fair.

Horse Judging 25 pt.; Hippology 25 pt.; = 50 points for the day. Horse Bowl 25 pt.; *Individual Presentation, *Team Presentation, *Public Speaking, 25 pt. total, (whether you do one or all three), and Impromptu Speaking 10 pt. = 60 points total for day.

This program has been set up to see the 4-H Horse members get involved in the Program. There are so many educational opportunities for each child and leader. The more involved you are the more you will learn!
