4-H Resume

- Each page provides instructions for filling it out.
- The same activity can be used more than once if you carried multiple roles in the activity. (Example: Your club packaged food at Marion/Polk Food Share AND you made the arrangements for your club to be there)
- Only put the year on the first entry of each page (like the example shows)

4-H Story/Notes

- Neatness counts, have someone read over your work.
- Double space handwritten in ink or typed 12 point font in Ariel or Times New Roman
- Story length: minimum of two pages and up to a maximum of six pages, short stories are ok, as long as they address the following: history of your projects, citizen/leadership, member's growth/plans, and 4-H Significant Activity
- New story must be submitted each year.
- It can be formal, diary, journal, story or newsy
- BE CREATIVITY

Horse Project Records

- Records need to be done on each horse you have entered in the Fair
- Please do not total your records for Fair, this is done in September
 You will not be counted down if your records are complete
- On the feed record not all boxes have to be filled in, they can be left blank if you did not have anything to go in that column.
- Either Board/Pasture Rent OR Home Pasture need to be filled out, but not both. There is a cost, even if you do not board your horse.

Animal Science Project Records-Junior

- Things I Hope to Do and Learn- Should have at least 3 sentences.
- Things I did with my 4-H Club- Should have at least 3 sentences.
- My project expenses- This area would include medications purchased, feed, animals purchased, vet bills and the cost of transporting your animal (home, to the Fair, to Weigh-ins) and the purchase of new supplies.
- My project income- If you sold eggs, offspring, wool, supplies
- My project inventory- Anything you had on hand when you started 4-H or October 1st of the current year if this is not your 1st year in 4-H.

Animal Science-Intermediate/Senior

- Things I Hope to Do and Learn- Should have at least 3 sentences.
- Animal Bird Inventory/Purchases- All of your project animals should be listed in this space. If you have them when you started your project or at the beginning of the club year they will have a starting value, if you purchase them after the beginning of the year (example market animal they would only have an ending value)
- Equipment Supplies and Feed Inventory- What you have on hand at the beginning of the year and the end of the year. If something is purchased throughout the year, it would only have an ending value.

Animal Science-Intermediate/Senior

- Other Expenses- Vet Bills, transportation, weigh-in fee, boarding/value if you keep your animal at home.
- Feed Record- List all types of feed for your animal. If you and your sibling feed the same thing and you buy it in bulk you need to figure out how much each animal is fed. (Example: 10 50 lb. bags of feed purchased in March for \$12.00 a bag, you feed 3 animals and your sibling feeds 2 animals). How would you calculate your feed cost for this amount of feed.

10 bags x 50 lbs= 500 lbs of feed/5 animals= 100 lbs 10 bags x \$12.00= \$120.00/5 animals= \$24.00 per animal

Animal Science-Intermediate/Senior

 Income- Any income you make from your project- sale of animals, animal products (wool, eggs, milk), sale of offspring, money made if project shown in a jackpot show.
