Dog Bones and Dog Parts Contest

Both contests will be held, consecutively, with Dog Bowl in February. Youth will be allowed ample time to complete the tests. Tests are scored and ribbons awarded based on the percentage of correct responses. All participants will receive a ribbon at the Dog Bowl awards ceremony.

Member Information

You will receive a diagram of a dog with various boxes pointing to different bones or parts of the dog. It will include a numbered answer list with all the bones, and parts for your age group. Your job is to match up the correct box on the dog diagram to the number on the list.

At the contest:

- 1. Pick up the colored Bones and Parts picture sheets for your age division. The parts and the skeletal diagram will appear on the top of the sheet and the numbered answers for just your age group will be below it.
- 2. Match the name of the bone or part with the number on the diagram. The bones and parts required for your age level are on the contest form, in case you forget which ones you need to identify. The numbers will be rearranged slightly from what you see the diagram, so be certain you know the terms in *any* order.
- 3. Juniors will have 2 extra answers, Intermediates will have 3 extra answers and Seniors will have 5 extra answers. Each age division will match only 10 parts and 10 bones.
- 4. Be sure your name and club is on the diagram sheet when you are finished,
