Breed ID Scoring Guidelines

Objective: Members will study and learn about various AKC breeds of dogs and be able to

identify dogs that they see, know what AKC group they belong to and what country they

originated from.

Test: Members will be shown pictures of dogs (only dogs that are in the AKC Dog Book for Kids

may be used for this contest) and given a list of possible breeds, AKC groups and countries of

origin.

First year members (encompasses all age levels) will be shown pictures of commonly known

dogs and must identify the breed. Bonus points will be awarded for correct identification of the

group and/or country of origin. First year members may chose to play at their age level rather

than as a first year member.

Juniors must identify the breed of dog and will be awarded bonus points for correct

identification of the group and/or country of origin.

Intermediates must identify the breed of dog and group. Bonus points will be awarded for

correct identification of the country of origin.

Seniors must identify the breed of dog, group and country of origin. Bonus points will be

awarded for correct identification of the breed and/or group and/or country of origin from a

select group of pictures.

Scoring: Country of origin determination will be from the AKC Dog Book for Kids and from the

most current AKC Dog Breed poster. The breed must be correctly identified to earn group or country of origin points. If a members transposes two answers on the answer sheet (for

example, #23 and #24 or correct but listed in the opposite order) the answers will be accepted.

Bonus points will count as ½ point towards the total score. Scoring is computed as a percent

based on the number of pictures shown and does not include potential bonus points in the

computation for Blue, Red, or White.

Blue: 80-100% correct

Red: 60-80% correct

White: 60% and below
