## **Animal Science Record**

- List all expenses for your animal(s) including enrollment fees, animals, and feed purchased throughout the year.

- List beginning value and ending value. As a rule of thumb, depreciate your inventory by 3% each year. For example: Beg. Value =\$20.00; end value: \$20.00 x 0.03=\$0.60; therefore \$20.00-\$0.60=\$19.40.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Enter the type of feed across the top and how much you feed EACH month down the left side. Break it down by month, not just bulk of feed.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Be sure to fill out the income page of the Animal Science record.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Separate market price and above market price under "Income from Sales of Animals".
- \_\_\_\_\_ Feed/Growth totals should equal the totals on the Animal Science record.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Feed/Growth record: show the end result as a profit or loss. Loss is shown with a negative sign or brackets, i.e.: \$35.00 or <\$35.00>.
