

Multi Use Wallet

Cutting Directions: 1- 5 ½ X 7 ½ Exterior
 2- 5 ½ X 7 ¾ Lining
 2- 5 ½ X 5 ½ Large Pockets
 2- 5 ½ X 4 Small Pockets
 2- 8 inch strips of Ribbon (grosgrain is best).
 1- 3 inch strip of ¼ inch elastic

Iron all the lining, Large pockets and small pockets pieces so they measure the 5 ½" wide.

1. Layer pieces in a sandwich in the following order:
 - Exterior fabric RS up. If you have an embellishment on your cover place it to the right.
 - Center ribbon pieces along the short ends in the center and pin in place.
 - Small pockets with raw edges matching up.
 - Large pockets with raw edges matching up.
 - Lining pieces with the folded edges overlapping in the center and the raw edges matching up.
2. Pin through all of the layers.
3. Sew around entire perimeter with ¼ seam allowance.
4. Clip corners
5. Turn wallet RSO and press.
6. Fold elastic in half and insert the raw edges in between the lining pieces centered. This should be the middle of the wallet. Sew along the spine securing the elastic.
