Scholarship description: The Klamath-Lake County Farm Bureau scholarship is a one-time grant of \$500. There will be four \$500 scholarships granted, two in Klamath County and two in Lake County, if the applicant pool allows.

3. The following must be included to be considered for a scholarship. If any of the following items are not included, the applicant will be disqualified.
  - completed application with handwritten essay (The application is four pages including the essay)
  - two current letters of recommendation (see requirements)
  - current official high school transcript
4. Application with essay, letters of recommendation, and transcript must be postmarked on or before May 15<sup>th</sup> of this year. Applications and/or accompanying documents postmarked after May 15<sup>th</sup> are considered ineligible.
