What are County Medals?

A county medal is recognizing a 4-H member’s growth in the work they have done in a particular project area. It looks at the project skills learned, as well as community service, mentorship, and/or demonstrated leadership in which the member has participated. It recognizes the individual rather than the project. In other words, county medals recognize “blue-ribbon” 4-H members rather than blue-ribbon projects. You may only win a specific county medal once per project in each age division.

Who is eligible for a County Medal?

Current Enrolled Junior, Intermediate & Senior Gilliam County 4-H members may apply.

How many medals can a 4-H member receive in a year?

Members may receive only one medal per year and members may receive a medal once per age division.

How does a member apply for a county medal?

To apply for a county medal, members should submit the following:

A) **This County Medal Application Form**-Must be complete, signed by each leader in project area & applicant

AND

B) **Record Book:** 4-H Resume & Most Recent Year’s 4-H Project Records (including Advancements, Production Records if applicable,). Records should be finished with final totals, project completion, and all signatures.

C) Must receive a **Gold Seal** award on record book.
