

4-H MASTER SHOWMANSHIP SCORE SHEET

Note: Judge may use this sheet as a guide to scoring a member's performance. The categories of *Animal Equipment* and *Subject Matter Knowledge* are scored on the first rotation along with *Showing the Animal* and *Club Member* (125 points). The first rotation score is weighted because it is the high placing showmanship animal and member representing that species. Subsequent rotations will only take into account scoring *Showing the Animal* and *Club Member* categories (75 points). The contestants rotate from animal to animal. Judges remain with assigned animal. Each contestant receives one total score from each judge. Total possible points is 500 for six species. A time frame of 5-7 minutes per species is recommended.

Animal and Equipment--25 points Appropriate equipment is clean, safe, and in good condition. Animal is clean, healthy, and properly groomed.			
Subject matter knowledge--25 points (i.e., equipment, production, and health)			
Showing the animal--50 points Includes: following directions, moving, turning, setting up, stopping, showing to advantage, control (safety) and attention to judge and animal			
Club member--25 points Includes: neat and clean, properly dressed, prompt, alert, confident (poised), and courteous
