The training will be indoors.

Know what publications you have and what year they were published. PNW 4-H publications will be available to update your documents or to pick up at no cost if you don't have current editions.

A new notebook will be handed out, but will not include every publication and handout; it will include specifically what you will need at the training.

Seating at the arena will be bleachers, so if you want a specific type of chair, bring it with you.

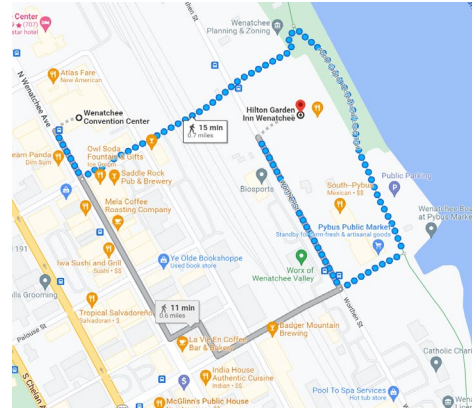
