

EOLS Auction Committee Scholarship

The Eastern Oregon Livestock Show Auction Committee is offering two \$1,000 Scholarships to 4-H and FFA High School Seniors who have participated at least 3 years in the livestock market animal program at EOLS in Union, Oregon. Years do not have to be consecutive or participating their senior year. Those applying must be currently enrolled in the 4-H or FFA program and in good standing. Successful recipients will be announced at the 2023 EOLS Junior Auction

Criteria:

1. Currently enrolled 4-H or FFA Member in good standing
2. Have shown a market animal at the Eastern Oregon Livestock Show for at least 3 different years (any combination is acceptable)
3. Currently a High School Senior
4. Submit the name and contact information of the County 4-H Agent or FFA Advisor who can verify 3 years of participation in the EOLS show

Submit answers to the following questions. Each question is LIMITED to 1 page, size 12 font, double spaced.

1. Explain your involvement in the Eastern Oregon Livestock Show.
2. What types of community service activities have you participated in?
3. Why is the Eastern Oregon Livestock Show important to you?
4. How do you plan to give back to this community and the Eastern Oregon Livestock Show in the future?
5. Attach a 4-H Resume/SAE Records
6. Submit a brief applicant (bio) abstract (150 words max) for use in award announcement at auction
7. Name and contact information of the County 4-H Agent or FFA Advisor who can verify 3 years of participation in the EOLS show

Review Process: Applications will be reviewed, scored and ranked by a neutral committee of three representing the following departments: 4-H community, FFA community and a past president of EOLS Board of Directors. Committee members will serve a three year term then will rotate off and be replaced with a new representative of that department. To allow for only one member rotating off each year, terms will stagger the first three years until a stable rotation is in place. At the completion of 2022 the EOLS Past President will rotate off; after 2023 the 4-H representative will rotate off. At the conclusion of 2024 the FFA representative will be replaced.
