Sheep: 105 lbs

Swine: 220 lbs

Beef: 1100 lbs

Goats: 75 lbs

Poultry: Fryers: 4-6 lbs, Roasters: 6.1 and higher

Rabbits: Fryers: 3.5-5.5 lbs, Roasters 5.6-9.0 lbs

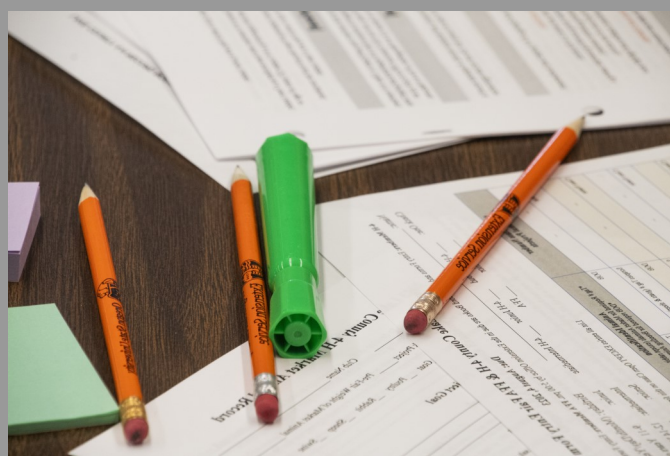
