Clayton Dill set the pace for the Oregon team tied for 12th place overall (in the top 10% in the nation) followed by Kutler Don at 34th place overall, Sawyer Rhodes in 83rd and Carter Borton in 92nd. #### State Fair YOCA Training

There is a new requirement for youth planning to show Horse, Dog, Small Animals and Livestock at state fair this year. Members who plan to show animals at state fair are required to take the national Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) training before attending state fair. They will be required to show their certificate of completion at state fair registration.

This requirement is outlined in item (2) of the state fair animal science guidelines, located in the state fair handbook linked here.

The Online version costs \$12 and can be found at <u>yqcaprogram.org</u>. A help guide that walks you step by step through the process can be found here. If you have questions give us a call at the Extension Office and we will be happy to assist!

#### **Breeding and Static Scholarships**

These scholarships are for youth who need financial assistance getting their breeding or static project started for the next 4-H year. Interviews will be held the week before fair. Check out the application on our website. Due July 26th to the Extension Office.



#### **Buyer Photo Specifications**

Photos for the auction buyer posters will be submitted electronically again this year. This allows members to take photos ahead of time. See below for the photo specifications. #### PHOTO SPECIFICATIONS:

- Photos are to be taken in LANDSCAPE orientation, NOT square or portrait.
- Photos are to be submitted in color with no added filters, effects, or words.
- Photos should be taken against a "nice" backdrop, free of trash and other people or animals.
- Members should wear show ring appropriate clothing: pants, nice shirt, closed-toed shoes, or FFA official dress. **NO T-SHIRTS**, with the exception of club t-shirts, allowed. **NO HATS**, with the exception of club hats and cowboy hats, allowed. No sunglasses.
- Project animal should be clean and "set-up".
- Members will be notified if their photos <u>do not</u> meet the above requirements and they will need to submit another picture.

#### PHOTO SUBMISSION:

- Photos are to be submitted electronically to: crookco4hlivestock@oregonstate.edu
- One picture per email with member's first and last name and ear tag # of the animal in the subject line. If the member has a backup animal and is still unsure which animal will be coming to fair, please submit an email for each animal labeled as above with "backup" added to the subject line of the appropriate email and we will make note of which animal is used at fair weigh in.
- Photos may be submitted beginning Monday, July 1, 2024, to the above email address.
- Photos MUST be received by Friday, July 19, at 5:00 pm
- These photos are the member's responsibility and must be submitted by the deadline. If you are unable to submit photos electronically, please contact Samara at the Extension office 541-447-6228 to discuss alternative submission options.

Remember that these photos will be displayed across our region, so please make sure to represent yourself, your club, and your Crook County 4-H program well!
